



1st Uxbridge All-Section Camp 2014



1st Uxbridge Group Committee is pleased to announce our 12th Annual All-Section camp. The camp will take place on the weekend of September 19-21, 2014 at Camp Endobanah, in Norland. Beavers (along with a Parent), Cubs, Scouts, Venturers and Rovers will be attending.

The actual cost per-person for this camp averages \$55 per person for food and camp rental fees. However, through our Apple Day Fundraising efforts we are able to offer this camp at a price of **\$30 per person**. (Continued support of Apple Day, Saturday, October 18, 2014 will ensure camp fees are kept as low as possible).

Please make Camp cheques payable to **Scouts Canada-1st Uxbridge**. All forms & fees must be received by September 12. **Parents/Guardians wishing to attend must complete & return the "Hold Harmless Agreement" form. Please put your name as the participant.** Also note the requirements for parents wishing to participate in an overnight event.

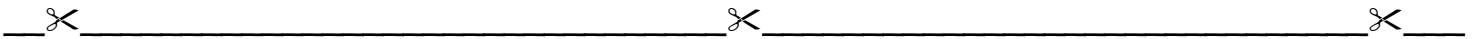
If required, any medication for youth must be in its original container and have the instructions clearly labelled. Please provide enough medication to last the weekend. Put it in a Ziploc bag with the youth's name written on it, and give it to the Leader in charge. We cannot be responsible for any medication the youth keep in their possession. Please speak with your Section Leader prior to the camp if you have any specific instructions regarding health/medication/food allergies.

If any parent has Lifeguarding skills and is intending to come to camp, please let us know as we are intending to have some waterfront activities.

Beavers, Cubs & Parents will be sleeping in cabins. Older youth will be sleeping in tents.

We will be meeting at St. Joseph's Catholic School parking lot at 6:15pm. on Friday evening and will be leaving promptly at 6:30pm (Please have dinner before coming to camp). We will be returning to Uxbridge at approximately 3:30pm on Sunday Sept 21.

Please Note: As per Scouts Canada's regulations, leaders are not permitted to arrange transportation to and from camp. Arranging transportation is the responsibility of each parent.

Kit List

Please make sure *everything* is labelled.

Each youth participant must bring at least the following;

CLOTHING

- Uniform (to be worn to and from camp).
- 3 complete changes of clothing
- Jacket
- Sun hat (Baseball caps are acceptable).
- Raincoat & boots
- Extra pair of dry shoes
- Bathing suit & towel

TOILETRIES

- Mosquito repellent
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Comb or hair brush
- Soap
- Face cloth and towel
- Handkerchief or tissues

A plastic garbage bag (for dirty and wet clothes)

SLEEPWEAR

- Pyjamas
- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow

Other/Optional

- ◆ Compass
- ◆ Flashlight
- ◆ Reading Material
- ◆ Campfire Blanket

PARTICIPANTS MUST NOT BRING

- ⊙ Knives or Axes
- ⊙ Radios, iPods, Cell Phones, etc.
- ⊙ Video games or Game boys
- ⊙ Valuables of any kind
- ⊙ Food, snacks, drinks or treats
- ⊙ Any medication unless it is given to the Scouter in Charge.

Requirements for Volunteers (Parents) during an Overnight event

Scouts Canada – By-Laws, Policies & Procedures

Section 3001.2 – Screening Level Required for all Adult Volunteers

Beaver Parents

- It is understood that the Parent/Guardian's primary responsibility lies with their own child. That said, it is acceptable for the Parent/Guardian to provide occasional assistance with meals/activities, etc. Provided they do so while under the supervision of two registered Scouters.
- Discussion of expectations
- Duty of Care review.
- Introduction of individual to youth, including their role.

All other adult Volunteers at Camp

- Orientation to the role and expectations.
- Personal Reference Checks (3).
- **Clean current Police Records Check as verified by Group Committee Chair/Group Commissioner.**
- Duty of Care review.
- Introduction of individual to youth, including their role.

In order to ensure compliance to the Scouts Canada regulations, all parents, except Beaver Parents, wishing to attend an overnight camp must provide a clean Police Records Check and three personal references.

The closest location to Uxbridge is the North Durham unit of Durham Regional Police Service located at 15765 Hwy 12, just south of Reach St. **The following was taken directly from the DRPS web site.**

As of January 1, 2012, the fee for all Criminal Information Requests, commonly referred to as CIRs or background checks, is \$20.00 for volunteers and \$55.00 for all other requests. Only exact change will be taken (a receipt will be given). Acceptable forms of payment are: cash, Visa, Mastercard, Debit, certified cheque, money order or bank draft.

If you are an applicant seeking a volunteer position within the community, you must state on the form what agency or community group you will be volunteering with.

- An appointment is not required to apply for the background (CIR) check.
- Criminal Information Requests must be made to the Durham Regional Police Service IN PERSON.
- Two pieces of identification are required. Social insurance cards and health cards WILL NOT be accepted. At least one piece of identification should have a photo of the applicant.
- Requests must be paid in cash. A receipt will be given. Please keep this receipt - the number on the top right corner will be used by our staff to reference your CIR.
- While we endeavour to process requests within 10 business days, an applicant's previous address history and unpredictable increases in demand for this service, depending on the time of year, can result in processing delays of several weeks.

- CIRs will be mailed to the applicant unless specific arrangements have been made for pick-up.. Only the applicant can pick up the criminal information request. Identification must be shown at the desk.
 - Completed Criminal Information Requests will only be kept on file for 60 days after the processing date.
 - Front counter clerks at each community office will assist applicants to fill out the form
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Please contact your Section Leader or Group Commissioner to obtain a Volunteer Letter from Scouts Canada. Your full name and birth date will be required. Alternatively, you can email your request to uxscout@gmail.com
